Paper manuscripts should be prepared in English. All submissions will undergo a blind

peer review process. Only accepted papers are published in the conference proceedings

and considered for oral presentation. Posters are the other alternative of oral

presentations.

- Being original work that has never been submitted for publication elsewhere;

- Being between 8,000 to 10,000 words in length and prepared on A4 size papers
